SUMMARY

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

The City's Municipal Code requires that the Traffic Commission select a Chair and a Vice Chair at their regular meeting in January. Due to Commission Appointments being conducted in January, the Traffic Commission annual reorganization will be done at the regular meeting in February. The City's Municipal Code reads as follows.

"2.48.050 Officers—Election and vacancy.

- A. *The officers of the Traffic Commission shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a Secretary. The Chairman and Vice Chairman shall be elected annually at the first regular meeting in the month of January, and shall hold office for a term of one year or until a successor is duly elected and qualified. Election shall be by a majority vote cast by those commissioners present and voting at the meeting at which the election is held. Officers shall assume office immediately."*

DISCUSSION

After convening the item, procedure calls for the Chair to temporarily relinquish the Chair to the Secretary in order that election for the Office of Chair may be conducted. The newly-elected Chair would then conduct the election for the Office of Vice Chair. A second is not required for nominations and nominations will be considered in the order received if more than one Commissioner is nominated.

SUMMARY

Willdan has completed the Engineering and Traffic Survey (E&TS) for 17 segments on 7 different roadways in the City of Los Alamitos.

RECOMMENDATION

Hold discussion, receive and file.

BACKGROUND

The California Vehicle Code (CVC) requires that engineering and traffic surveys be performed to establish or revise prima facie speed limits on certain streets within a local jurisdiction, before law enforcement can utilize radar or other electronic devices for enforcement. These surveys must be updated periodically to reflect current conditions; the last engineering and traffic survey was conducted in 2014.

These surveys must be updated every 5 or 7 years to ensure the speeds reflect current conditions.

DISCUSSION:

The fundamentals for establishing speed limits recognize that the majority of drivers behave in a safe and reasonable manner, and therefore, the normally careful and competent actions of a reasonable driver should be considered legal. Speed limits established on these fundamentals conform to the consensus that those who drive the roadways determine what speed is reasonable and safe, not on the judgment of one or a few individuals. A radar speed study is usually used to record the prevailing speed of reasonable drivers.

The California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (California MUTCD) dated November 2014 specifies the methodology to be used for completing Engineering and

Traffic Surveys. This methodology includes an evaluation of current vehicle speeds, accident history and conditions not readily apparent to motorists.

Existing vehicle speeds are surveyed by a certified radar operator with a calibrated radar unit in an unmarked vehicle. Speed samples are taken for each segment representing a statistically significant sample of current traffic. This data is then evaluated to identify the distribution of speeds. A key element in the evaluation is the identification of the 85th percentile speed. The 85th percentile speed is the speed at or below which 85 percent of the traffic travels. This threshold represents what is historically found to be a safe and reasonable speed for most drivers based on common roadway conditions. Therefore, a speed limit is established at the nearest 5-mile per hour (mph) increment to the 85th percentile speed, except as shown in the two options below.

Options:

1. The posted speed may be reduced by 5 mph from the nearest 5 mph increment of the 85th-percentile speed, in compliance with CVC Section 627 and 22358.5.
2. For cases in which the nearest 5 mph increment of the 85th percentile speed would require a rounding up, then the speed limit may be rounded down to the nearest 5 mph increment below the 85th percentile speed, if no further reduction is used. Refer to CVC Section 21400(b).

If the speed limit to be posted has had the 5 mph reduction applied, then an E&TS shall document in writing the conditions and justification for the lower speed limit. The reasons for the lower speed limit shall be in compliance with CVC Section 627 and 22358.5.

The following examples are provided to explain the application of these speed limit criteria:

- A. Using Option 1 above and first step is to round down: If the 85th percentile speed in a speed survey for a location was 37 mph, then the speed limit would be established at 35 mph since it is the closest 5 mph increment to the 37 mph speed. As indicated by the option, this 35-mph established speed limit could be reduced by 5 mph to 30 mph if conditions and justification for using this lower speed limit are documented in the E&TS.
- B. Using Option 1 above and first step is to round up: If the 85th percentile speed in a speed survey for a location was 33 mph, then the speed limit would be established at 35 mph since it is the closest 5 mph increment to the 33 mph speed. As indicated by the option, this 35-mph speed limit could be reduced by 5 mph to 30 mph if the conditions and justification for using this lower speed limit are documented in the E&TS.
- C. Using Option 2 above and first step is to round up: If the 85th percentile speed in a speed survey for a location was 33 mph, instead of rounding up to 35 mph, the

speed limit can be established at 30 mph, but no further reduction can be applied.

Table 1 identifies the street segments with recommended posted speed limits.

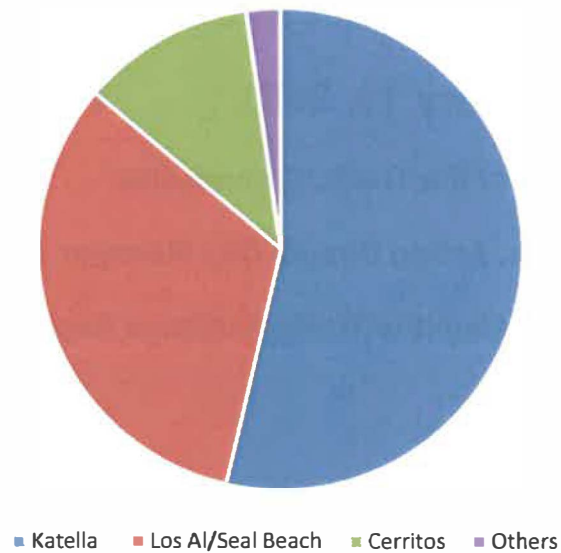
Background

- Others - 14

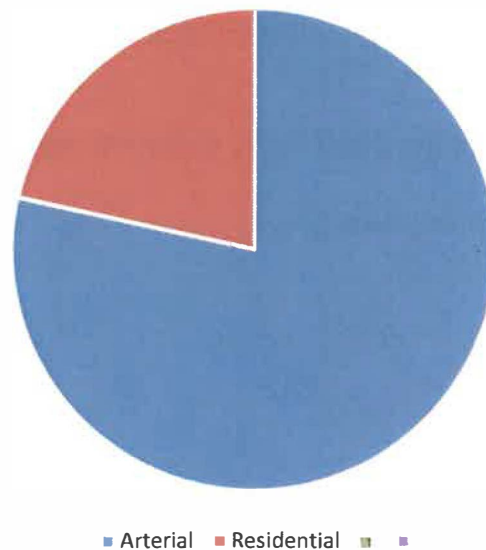
2020 Traffic Collision Report

Attention Traffic Commissioners:

Recently, a citizen brought a concern to our meeting (Planning Commission) which I would like to share with you. She has just witnessed a mother pushing her baby stroller across Los Alamitos Blvd in the crosswalk in front of Southland Bank which a car failed to slow down or stop nearly hitting these individuals. I also have witnessed near incidents at this crosswalk and I am very concerned that it is not a question of if but when will someone be injured. I am addressing this with you as a citizen and not as a commissioner. My request: I would appreciate the traffic commissioner reevaluating safety measures for this crosswalk. I do believe this crosswalk is essential and removing it will only promote jaywalking which only continues to put our citizens at risk.

Along with this crosswalk, I would like to address the corner of Florista and Los Alamitos Blvd. I have been physically hit (with only minor injury) in the crosswalk several times by cars traveling west making a left hand turn. I have seen several students from Oak Middle School in the same situation. The major concern is the left turn lane traffic fails to see pedestrians in the crosswalks either due to the blinding sun light or failure on their part to pay attention. Sadly, this situation has occurred in both crosswalks on Los Alamitos Blvd for the west and east bound left turn lanes. I currently have no solution other than potentially placing warning signs re: crosswalks and pedestrians. I hope you will be able to address this situation and find a potential solution.

Thank you for your time. Again, I am addressing this as a Los Alamitos citizen and not a commissioner.
