Chair Mejia asked about the following and then shared about City of Huntington Beach Air Show:

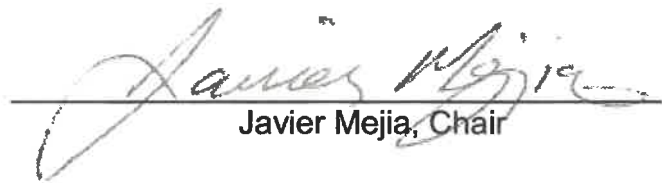
- The pole that was hit on Farquhar Avenue and Los Alamitos Boulevard
