A. Findings Required by AB 361 for the Continued Use of Teleconferencing for Meetings

For the Traffic Commission to continue to have the option to meet via teleconference during the pandemic, AB 361 requires the Traffic Commission to make specific findings at least every thirty (30) days.

Recommendation:

Make the following findings by a majority vote of the Traffic Commission:

1. A state of emergency has been proclaimed by California's Governor due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and continues to be in effect;
2. The Traffic Commission has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency; and
3. State and local officials continue to recommend measures to promote social distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19.

6. STAFF REPORTS

A. Traffic Order Item 22-03 (Development Services)

In August 2022, the Code Enforcement Division received requests from local business owners to restrict overnight vehicles from parking on various City streets. The Code Enforcement Division investigated the request and verified that numerous commercial vehicles are parked on Humbolt Street, Calle Lee Avenue, and Corporate Center Drive. Staff is recommending restricting overnight vehicle parking according to Los Alamitos Municipal code section 10.24.090.

Recommendation:

1. Consider and discuss restricting overnight commercial vehicle parking on Humbolt Street, Calle Lee Avenue, and Corporate Center Drive.

2. Approval of staff recommendation to restrict overnight commercial vehicle parking on Humbolt Street, Calle Lee Avenue, and Corporate Center Drive in accordance to Los Alamitos Municipal code section 10.24.090.
