A. Pine Street Project PS&E

Currently, Pine Street serves as the downtown corridor of Los Alamitos, hosting many of our community events. The goal of this project is to revitalize Pine Street to reflect a true main-street atmosphere that supports and enhances the events held along the corridor. The project will transform Pine Street into the City's "Main Street" by creating a walkable, welcoming, and vibrant mixed-use Town Center district.

The proposed complete-street improvements include new sidewalks, ADA enhancements, LED lighting, street furniture, street trees, wayfinding signage, enhanced pedestrian crossings, and an entry plaza with a gateway monument. The corridor will also be designed to allow for temporary closure to traffic for City events, markets, and celebrations—strengthening its role as the heart of downtown Los Alamitos.

In addition, this investment directly supports the City's Economic Development initiatives by creating an attractive and pedestrian-friendly environment that encourages foot traffic, supports local businesses, and invites new commercial opportunities. A revitalized Pine Street will help stimulate business activity, attract visitors, increase storefront visibility, and foster a stronger sense of place—ultimately contributing to the community's long-term economic vitality and growth.
